Quantity limitations are applied by drug category and dosage format. Quantity limitations do not apply to medication authorised as Chronic.

Chronic medication is authorised individually with each case reviewed on its own merit, in accordance with Scheme rules, managed healthcare principles and evidence based medicine. Not all chronic medication is listed on this formulary, but may be accessed via treatment algorithms on review of an application for authorisation.
